I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. And the life that I now live in my body, I live by faith, indeed, by the faithfulness of God's Son, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Galatians 2:20

Which of these is a bigger struggle for you today?

- 1. Humbly recognizing and admitting your need for Jesus.
- 2. Trusting that Jesus's saving work was done for you.

In the verse above, Paul shows the incredible power of the gospel message. He shares the humble understanding that he needs Christ continually in his life. He also shows his belief of Jesus's love and sacrifice for him. Both are essential to the Christian life.

In the story of the prodigal son (Luke 15), Jesus shows how the older brother needed to be humbled and the younger son, who was lost, needed Jesus' saving work to find him and restore him.

Part of the good news of Jesus is that he can accomplish both these tasks. He can help us humbly remember our need for salvation in those times when all is going well and we are prosperous. He can also give us grace and hope when we have blown it and we cannot convince ourselves we deserve a second chance.

He is an amazing savior and I pray you grow to love him more and more.
