

#### WESLEY DAY SCHOOL REPORT

Wesley Day School is a ministry of Wesley UMC that operates during the school year from September to May. Our school hours are M-Th 9:00 AM until 1:45 PM. Tuition is \$310.00 a month. We open registration to current enrolled students and church members in mid-January and to the public in February of each year. We have a waiting list every year and when it is time for registration, we have people show up in line around 7:00 AM waiting for doors to open at 9:00 AM. We offer early drop 8-9:00 AM for an extra fee of \$140.00 a month and we have after school care until 5:00 for an additional fee of \$300 a month. Both of these options usually have a waiting list because we only allow so many spots to for this service.

We usually have 150-160 enrolled students ages 12 months to 4/5 years (pre K age). This year our enrollment is down and we have 120 students. Covid issues have affected not only enrollment but less staff and substitute teachers. We are prayerful that this will improve over time. Enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year begins February 4th for current families, day school staff and church members. Enrollment will be open to the public on February 16th. Again, we pray that we see an increase in student enrollment thus the ability to increase staff as well.

We have a school board that consists of 8-9 church members. They each serve a 3 year term. They meet monthly to discuss budget, school events, staffing, student enrollment, campus improvements etc. We are very fortunate to be supported in this way.

The school is funded through tuition payments and 2 fundraisers. One fundraiser is in the fall around Thanksgiving and one fundraiser is in the spring during our annual Art Show. We pay rent to the church yearly for our use of the education building.

We support our community with an annual food drive for Some Other Place during the month of November. We support our church by always sharing the good news about activities and events going on via social media and fliers that go out too all our families.

We are all happy to serve the church by working at the day school and ministering to the young children in our care.
