## **Schlesinger Youth Welfare Foundation**

In June 1957 A. W. Schlesinger established the Schlesinger Youth Welfare Foundation for the "establishment and advancement of a youth program at North End Methodist Church." Mr. Schlesinger was devoted to the youth of the church and the pastor at the time, Rev. Derwood Blackwell, with more than 80 men who were members of the official board of North End Methodist Church joined with him for the benefit of our youth program.

This foundation is part of the legacy of our church as we have grown and moved from the days of North End Methodist. And the list of names forms a record of the lineage of members and church families. Here are just a few of the names. — I.O. Dent, E. D. Parmer, Ralph Bistline, D. S. Canant, H. C. Hendrix, Paul Behrens, George Huckins, C. T. Helpinstill, Hubert Nelson, J. E. Ray, O. W. Smithey —
