### **Schlesinger Youth Welfare Foundation**

In June 1957 A. W. Schlesinger established the Schlesinger Youth Welfare Foundation for the "establishment and advancement of a youth program at North End Methodist Church." Mr. Schlesinger was devoted to the youth of the church and the pastor at the time, Rev. Derwood Blackwell, with more than 80 men who were members of the official board of North End Methodist Church joined with him for the benefit of our youth program.

This foundation is part of the legacy of our church as we have grown and moved from the days of North End Methodist. And the list of names forms a record of the lineage of members and church families. Here are just a few of the names. — I.O. Dent, E. D. Parmer, Ralph Bistline, D. S. Canant, H. C. Hendrix, Paul Behrens, George Huckins, C. T. Helpinstill, Hubert Nelson, J. E. Ray, O. W. Smithey —

### Thank you Church!

We had an amazing Day of Caring. It was a wonderful day of worship and service to our community and far beyond. With Rise Against Hunger, we packaged 14,472 meals that will be sent off shortly. I'll let you know where they are headed as soon as I find out. At Boys Haven, we primed and painted three full rooms. This will help them begin to open up this dormitory to more boys in foster care. Our youth packed over 2000 pounds of supplies, food, tools, Christmas trees, and firefighting equipment, which will be sent out this Friday on a shipment to Utila, Honduras. Finally, our New Beginnings Sunday School class packaged about 60 meals with Love Lunchsack, which were passed out to homeless members of our community.

Thank you again for all of your help. The Kingdom of God grows as our worship of Christ turns into our service of neighbor. Your commitment to this mission day made it our most successful ever. It continues to grow each year and we were well over 70 volunteers on Sunday. We have done good work and our relationships with each of these missions will only continue to grow in the months to come.


