

You can bring your aluminum cans for recycling and put them in the container near the Folsom entrance. Money is used for Methodist Men's group projects and local missions.



# FROM THE PASTOR

Jesus looked at him carefully and loved him.

He said, "You are lacking one thing.

Go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor. Then you will have treasure in heaven. And come, follow me."

Mark 10:21

So proudly we Protestants proclaim the truth of our salvation: you are saved by God's grace because of your faith (Eph. 2:8). We are saved by grace, not by works. We are emphatic about it. We are convinced by this truth and we hold no room for any other possible interpretation. I love this passage from Mark because it raises an important question about this truth. The man asked Jesus what he needs to do to enter into eternal life. Jesus gave an answer. 'Sell everything you own.' There's no mention of grace or of faith. It's a work for this man to do to inherit eternal life. How do we reconcile what Paul says with what Christ says? How do we reconcile the truth of our salvation that we have learned from Martin Luther and our Protestant background with the Gospel that is spoken by Jesus himself?

The answer here is simple, but sometimes easily forgotten. Please do not sacrifice Christ for the sake of Paul, or Martin Luther, or good theology. They sacrificed themselves for Christ. This man that Christ is speaking to needs to sell all that he owns and give the money to the poor. Then he needs to follow Jesus. These are imperatives for this man. He has been called by Christ to serve in this way and he is reluctant to do so. How might his story go if he sold all he owned and followed Christ? What good works would have been done in Christ's name? How might we have seen God's grace work in and through him to share Christ with others?

When Christ is calling us to serve or give in a particular way, recognize that it is God's grace working in us. We must respond faithfully. Don't let the theology of salvation by faith and not by works prevent you from doing work for Christ. Instead, let us see this type of work as an opportunity for God's saving grace to work through us and bring us closer to Him.


