

You can bring your aluminum cans for recycling and put them in the container near the Folsom entrance. Money is used for Methodist Men's group projects and local missions.



"So now there isn't any condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death." Romans 8:1-2

We all need hope.

There are always reasons and circumstances in our life that can cause us to be anxious, worried, or downcast. The news is always filled with upsetting events and we are never sure what will happen next.

I think this is one of the reasons I am thankful for my faith in Jesus. He always gives me hope about the future.

One place I find hope is in Romans 8. Paul reminds us in Jesus Christ our sins and mistakes can be forgiven, and our future becomes eternal.

This means we no longer need worry about a time in the future where we are found lacking or inadequate in the eyes of God or our own eyes. In Jesus Christ, our past is forgiven, and we are set free from the power of sin and death.

Romans 8 also tells us that we are set free from death! Death is usually at the root of much of our worry. The fear of our life ending and the worry we have over what that might mean often controls how we behave. In Jesus Christ, however, we are set free from the fear of death and know our life will be eternal with God.

That truth alone should give you hope for the future. Take time today to ask God to work in your heart to trust more and more in Jesus. Ask God to work in your life so that you not only know this hope in your heart but also share it with others.
