## "If you can hear, listen to what the Spirit is saying to the churches."

**Revelations 2:29** 

We believe in God in three persons, Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Three in one.

The third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit, is the most neglected and misunderstood one. The Holy Spirit is the one who helps us experience and become empowered by God's grace. I encourage you to take time to study and read about the person and work of the Holy Spirit but here a few points to consider.

When we fail to honor the work and presence of the Holy Spirit, we will struggle to find the authentic love of God in our hearts. The Holy Spirit is the one who is promised to both comfort us and assure us of our salvation and our place in the family of God. But with the Holy Spirit, we become fruitful like a vine connected to deep roots. We find a passion and love for God and God's mission in the world.

When we do not acknowledge the work of the Holy Spirit, our witness about God will lack authenticity and power. The Holy Spirit is the one who empowered the people of the early church to boldly witness and testify about Jesus to unbelievers. It was the work of the Holy Spirit that made their words capable of changing hearts and lives.

Asking the Holy Spirit to guide us will help us better understand the Bible and apply it to our lives. With the help of the Holy Spirit, we will better understand God's truth and find courage to follow it and apply it to our lives. The Holy Spirit also helps us discern and find clarity about what God wants for our world and us. The Holy Spirit has authority to direct and guide our lives and is essential for any church that wants to be a part of what God is doing in the world.

**Prayer:** Almighty God, to you all hearts are open, all desires known, and from you no secrets are hidden. Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you, and worthily magnify your holy name, through Christ our Lord. Amen.


