Jesus followed up. "Yes. For there was once a man who threw a great dinner party and invited many. When it was time for dinner, he sent out his servant to the invited guests, saying, 'Come on in; the food's on the table.' "Then they all began to beg off, one after another making excuses. The first said, 'I bought a piece of property and need to look it over. Send my regrets.' "Another said, 'I just bought five teams of oxen, and I really need to check them out. Send my regrets.' "And yet another said, 'I just got married and need to get home to my wife" Luke 14 :17-20

Jesus tells the story of someone who throws a big party and sends out invitations. The guest all accept the invitation but when the actual date of the party occurs they all give excuses as to why they cannot attend.

For me, the toughest part of the story Jesus shares above, is the fact all of the reasons the guest give are what we would call good excuses. We would all agree it was the responsible, right thing to watch over your property, tend to your business, and care for your spouse.

But Jesus was throwing a great party and all these people missed it. The story always makes me pause and think about the commitments in my life. Are there areas of my life I use as an excuse for not following Jesus?

He is my savior and Lord. Are there excuses I often give for why I cannot follow him? Do I decline his invitation because it is inconvenient? Do I make excuses for why I cannot show up where he calls me because of what others might think or say? Or maybe I don't even notice or hear his invitation because I am so focused chasing after the things of this world.

We all need to listen to the call and invitation of our savior. Surely the party he is throwing is worthy of our attendance!
