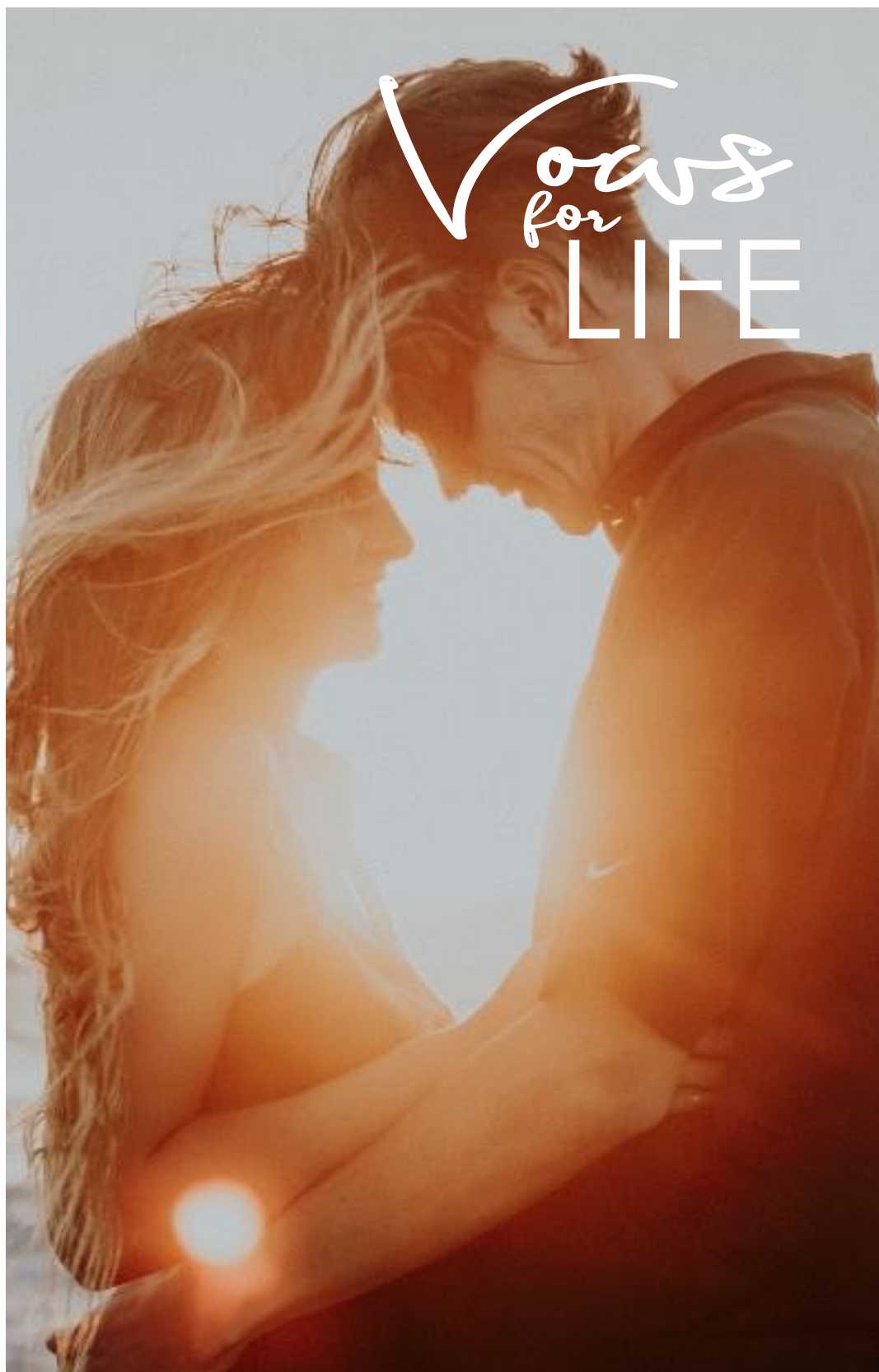

2 Peter 3

But there are a few times we should be willing to wait.

When we are angry, we should be willing to wait. Our emotions can get the best of us. Count to ten. Then you probably need to count 10 weeks before you do anything rash.

When we want to quit, we should wait. I know we want all want to push the eject or bail me out button when our job, marriage, or school are going in the direction that we don't like. But hang in there just a little longer.

When we are tempted, it is best to wait. Remember, there is never anything sinful about being tempted. But giving into temptation is costly and those costs escalate quickly over time.

When we think God is not moving fast enough for us, we should wait. As they say in other church traditions, “God does not always show up when we want God to, but God is always on time.”

Wait and see what God brings into your life. God is always on time!
