## Why do we give up something during lent?

Many Christians make personal sacrifice pledges to themselves during Lent, such as giving up chocolate, alcohol or coffee. But with that sacrifice should be a pledge to give something of yourselves, to walk in the path of Christ.

For us to be renewed, (we) have to take some kind of spiritual journey, or I call, a spiritual workout. If you want to work out and get healthy, you go and you train. This is a spiritual training time, and therefore, makes a person healthier. That's part of it, but another part of it is dieting and fasting. There's a difference between abstaining and fasting, such as abstaining from certain types of food like meat on Fridays, while fasting is limiting the amount of food you take. Downsizing is another good word. That's one aspect, which leads to renewal. Christians should also share the fruits of their fasting.

"When I deny myself, I need to place at the table somebody who is less fortunate and needy. That's the origin of Christian fasting. I hear people say, 'I'm not going to Starbucks during Lent. The money I save by not going to Starbucks, I can put aside and give it to the food pantry. We gather the fruits of the fast.

"It's not just writing a check, it's connected with our fasting and purifying ourselves. Fasting and abstinence needs to have the other side of the coin. What I deny myself, I have to give to somebody else."

And the people of Nineveh believed God. They proclaimed a fast and put on mourning clothes, from the greatest of them to the least significant. Jonah 3:5

A fast has been proclaimed. A season of repentance is at hand. We are a week into Lent. How's your fast going? I hope you haven't given up yet. If you have, just start again. It's not too late. If you never started your fast, start now. It's not too late. If you've struggled or given in a couple of times, keep trying. You can do this!

A fast is not meant to be easy. It's not meant to be simple. A fast tears us down and makes us weaker, by its very nature. But a fast doesn't have to be done alone. Our church is fasting right now. Christians around the world are fasting right now. We can support each other. One of the amazing things about the story of Jonah is that everybody in the city fasts. Everybody from the peasant all the way up to the king. Even the animals fast. I'm sure they all wanted to eat. I'm sure they all wanted to go back to work. But they sit in their mourning clothes and ask for forgiveness from God. And they do it together, knowing that everybody else is doing it, too. They fast as a community with the strength and encouragement from their neighbors and even their king.

Forty days is a long time to go without something that you have come to rely on, but you are not alone. Stay strong. Be encouraged. I am fasting with you, along with Christians around the world. You can do it!
