

## FROM THE PASTOR

The administrative council of Wesley UMC met on July 17<sup>th</sup> 2022 to vote on a resolution on whether or not we should enter a time of prayer, fasting, conversation, listening, and information sharing as a congregation (discernment). This is in response to concerns about current conflicts in the United Methodist Denomination and concerns about its future direction. The council voted to pass the resolution.

Please keep in mind this does not mean that Wesley UMC has or necessarily will leave the United Methodist Church.

This does mean that from July 17-Aug 31 there will be opportunities for you to gain more information, ask questions, talk with leaders and other members about the future of the church, and help determine where God is calling your church.

The exact schedule will be available soon.

When the council meets again at the end of this period, it will determine what the next best steps in the process will be with the help of your prayers and input.

Please keep the church in your prayers each day. Please also contact one of the church leaders or pastors if you have further questions.

Resolution on the Question of Disaffiliation Whereas, there is current deep conflict within the United Methodist Church around issues of human sexuality, and

Whereas, additional conflict exists around prospects for theological orthodoxy in the continuing UMC, whether United Methodist doctrine will change, or whether it will actually function as standards for our proclamation, teaching, and practice, and

Whereas, three paragraphs (¶2553, ¶2548.2, and, under some circumstances, ¶2549.3.b) in the current Book of Discipline may be used to complete a disaffiliation in which the congregation may retain much or all of its property and assets, but at the same time, ¶2553 is the only paragraph that creates any right for a congregation to disaffiliate while retaining property and assets, and

Whereas, under provisions of ¶2553 a local church has a limited right to disaffiliate from the denomination for reasons of conscience regarding a change in requirements and provisions of the Book of Discipline related to the practice of homosexuality or the ordination or marriage of self- avowed practicing homosexuals, and

Whereas, The Disaffiliation Process (Par. 2553) is the only exit not currently under challenge in the Judicial Commission and generally allowed by bishops, and must be completed by December 21, 2023, and

Whereas, whether to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church or to remain is a decision to be made by the local church congregation after an opportunity for the membership to pray, to become informed, to discuss, and communicate with one another,

The administrative council of Wesley United Methodist Church, Beaumont resolves to enter into a period of discernment from July 18 through August 31 to discern where God is leading this congregation with respect to the question of disaffiliation from the United Methodist Denomination.

The period of discernment will provide opportunity for seeking God's wisdom and His calling through prayer, seeking and receiving information, and communication. The period of discernment is intended to be a period of understanding the congregation, hearing from the church membership about their hopes for the future, and determining where God is calling our Church.
