It is expected of all who desire to continue in methodism that they should continue to evidence their desire of salvation.”

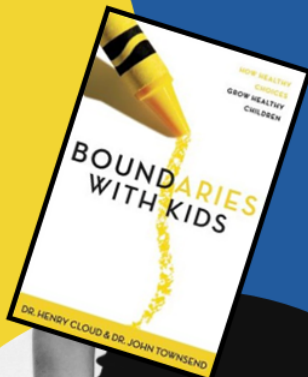
