Discernment UPDATE

On September 11, 2022 the Administrative Council of Wesley United Methodist Church approved the following resolution:

“After completing a period of prayerful discernment of more than 40 days, including a call to the membership for prayer and fasting, town hall meetings, publishing links to articles and videos about reasons for disaffiliation and about reasons to remain with the United Methodist Church, and after a survey open to the church membership, The Administrative Council of Wesley United Methodist Church, Beaumont resolves to request the District Superintendent to convene a church conference for the purpose of discussion and vote on whether Wesley United Methodist Church, Beaumont will disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church. The Administrative Council resolves further to request the District Superintendent to extend the vote to all members of the Wesley UMC, Beaumont who are present at such meeting.”

The vote to determine if Wesley United Methodist Church will disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church is currently scheduled for October 9, 12pm in the sanctuary.

Please keep in mind the following:

- You must be a member of Wesley UMC and present at the Charge Conference in order to vote.
- In order to disaffiliate from the UMC, 2/3 of members present at Charge Conference must approve the resolution to do so.
- Voting will be done by ballot.
- We will have our membership roll available in worship each week prior to the vote if you would like to make sure you are currently a member. You may also contact the office of Wesley UMC to check the status of your membership.

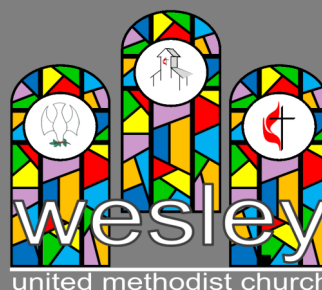

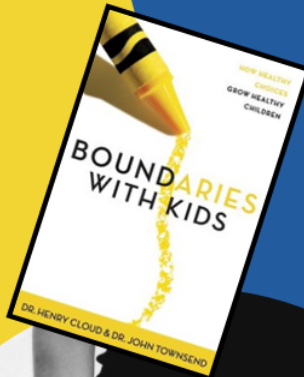
