C—Commission

Sending people to start new missions, churches, and ministries that grow the Kingdom of God. (Ephesians 4)

E—Evangelism

Sharing the good news of Jesus through preaching, teaching, and sharing Jesus in our daily conversations. (Romans 10:14)


