PRAYER CALENDAR by Don Sample

October 30, 2020 – Psalm 19:1-6; Psalm 103:1-2; Psalm 148; & 150; —>> Praise the Lord & worship God the Almighty, from everlasting to everlasting — (mark Psalm 148 & 150 before you begin this prayer so that you will be able to include them as part of your prayer)

O Lord God Almighty, I see the works of your hands. All of creation pours forth your glory day by day and night by night. Nothing was made that you did not make. How can I miss you? I cannot! Your manifest presence is unmistakable. And I join the psalmist to say, "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name." I worship and praise you O God. I fill my heart and my mouth with your praise —>>Now close this prayer as you say Psalms 148 & 150 out loud, praising God! (Don't be bashful).

October 31, 2020 - Proverbs 3:5; Proverbs 2:1-6; James 3:17 — Trust God; seek His wisdom from above and enjoy its benefits

I trust you, Lord, with all my heart. I thank you that I am able to trust you, for my own understanding is a blind guide. But when I acknowledge you, God, you make my paths straight. So, I seek your words and treasure your commandments and listen for your wisdom that I may find the understanding that is from God. Come Holy Spirit, I cry for discernment; I lift my voice for understanding. May I discover the knowledge of God. My Lord, Jesus, you said to the tempter, "It is written, 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God." rifice when I conform to the ways of this world. Have mercy upon me I pray. Renew my mind as I study and learn your word. Transform me and let me seek to not only know, but also to do that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. Let me keep my gaze upon you, and if I must look at myself, let it be only a glance. Instead, Father, guide me to see others as more important than myself. Give me faith and sound judgment. For I know this: I am not wise without you. I don't have the wisdom, the knowledge I need, and the ability to discern your will unless I seek you. So again, Lord, I pray. Renew me. Transform me. Use me.

November 3, 2020 – Colossians 3:15-17 — Let Christ live in you. In everything you think, let Him guide you. Do everything you do in the strong and mighty name of Jesus, giving thanks to God through him

Father, I surrender to the rule of Christ in my heart and ask that as you renew and transform my mind, lead my thoughts to be your thoughts; direct my every word and whatever I do in such a way that they reflect the love of the Lord Jesus Christ. And I thank you through Him for that.

COMMUNION RAIL OFFERING

Wesley UMC has partnered in ministry with FUMC Lake Charles. In the aftermath of Hurricanes Laura, Delta, and Zeta, there has been significant damage to the community and to members of FUMC Lake Charles. This means there has also been challenges to meet needs within the community that FUMC often is able to meet. This is where we want to help. FUMC has a ministry to feed homeless members of their community each day called Abraham's Tent. This is similar to Some Other Place in our community, but it is entirely operated through the church. We want to fund this ministry for them, so that they can continue to serve their community even as rebuilding begins after these series of storms. To do this, the Missions Team has agreed to send our Communion Rail offering from all three services to FUMC for the month of November. Additionally, we have agreed to match the first \$2,500 given so that we can send and help immediately with this wonderful ministry.
