

"38 Peter replied, "Change your hearts and lives.

Each of you must be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 This promise is for you, your children, and for all who are far away—as many as the Lord our God invites." 40 With many other words he testified to them and encouraged them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." 41 Those who accepted Peter's message were baptized.

God brought about three thousand people into the community on that day.

42 The believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to the community, to their shared meals, and to their prayers.

43 A sense of awe came over everyone. God performed many wonders and signs through the apostles."

Acts 2:38-42

What is the most important thing we do as a church?

On the day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit empowered a handful of disciples to transform the hearts of thousands. People turned toward God, were baptized into life together, and became passionate about the work God was starting. The world has never been the same.

This year our vision team has worked to discern the direction of Wesley UMC. The team realized that the most important task we complete as a church is still the same as it was on the day of Pentecost. The team summarized this important work as: Transforming hearts to be passionate for God's work.

When people come to understand who Jesus truly is and acknowledge that he is Lord and Savior, their hearts are transformed, and they become passionate about participating in the work that God is doing in the world.

This transformation is accomplished through the gracious work of the Holy Spirit when we worship, fellowship with other Christians, serve, pray, fast, read scripture, and practice other means of connecting with God.


