Elijah climbed to the top of Carmel, bowed deeply in prayer, his face between his knees. Then he said to his young servant, "On your feet now! Look toward the sea." He went, looked, and reported back, "I don't see a thing." "Keep looking," said Elijah, "seven times if necessary." And sure enough, the seventh time he said, "Oh yes, a cloud! But very small, no bigger than someone's hand, rising out of the sea." (1 Kings 18: 43-44)

It had not rained for over 3½ years. Drought, famine, and plenty of warnings from God had been sent in an effort to help people turn back to God. After confronting the wickedness of the people, God's prophet, Elijah had prayed and asked God to send the rain.
