We are having a special One Day of Service on May 24. As an act of service, immediately following worship, we will package thousands of meals for Rise Against Hunger to send internationally to communities struggling with food shortages. Due to the pandemic and the reality that Rise Against Hunger is an international organization, important health, and safety standards will be maintained for the packaging process. Additionally, because of Covid-19, much humanitarian aid has been halted around the world.
