**“Who among you will shut the doors
of the temple so that you don’t burn
something on my altar in vain?”**

Malachi 1:10

“But you say, “How tedious!” and you groan about it, says the Lord of heavenly forces.

Malachi gives us a vivid description of how lousy worship of God had gotten in the time before Jesus’ birth. The people found worship of God tedious, they gave the bare minimum instead of their best, and no one seemed to care. Instead of bringing their best sheep as an offering, they brought the ones they could not sell, which were probably on their last breath. Not even the priest paid much attention to how bad things had gotten. It was so bad God is hoping someone will just shut the doors so the lousy worship will end.

Careless, apathetic worship was how God characterized the people. God points out that if they were going to give a governor or an important friend a gift, they would give their best, not the bare minimum.

The opposite of careless, tedious worship? Worship that takes the greatness and glory of God seriously and seeks to pay attention and be attentive to honoring God. It means that we carefully prepare our lives and hearts for our times of worship. We don’t simply show up acting as God should just be happy we managed to show up. Instead, we pay attention to what is going on in our hearts and do everything we can to make sure we are giving our best each time we come to worship.

Jesus pointed out this meant making sure we were setting things right with our neighbors, working for God’s justice, and helping those in need. Doing the work God has given us, keeping close to God’s instruction, and adoring God above everything else prepares our hearts to be ready for worship each week.

May God pour out grace, mercy, and love into your heart to help you prepare for true and spiritual worship each week.

DID YOU KNOW?

The CARES Act allows a donor to elect to increase his or her deduction limit for certain 2020 charitable contributions. Without the election, the limitation would be 50% or 60% of the donor's adjusted gross income (without regard to net operating loss carrybacks).

For 2020, a taxpayer may elect to deduct certain cash charitable contributions up to 100% of his or her adjusted gross income.

Contributions made to private non-operating foundations, supporting organizations, and donor-advised funds do not qualify for this enhanced limitation, although they remain deductible up to the existing limits.

Non-cash donations (i.e., securities, personal property) do not qualify for this provision, although they are still deductible up to the existing limits.
