Our Endowment recognizes the following types of gifts:

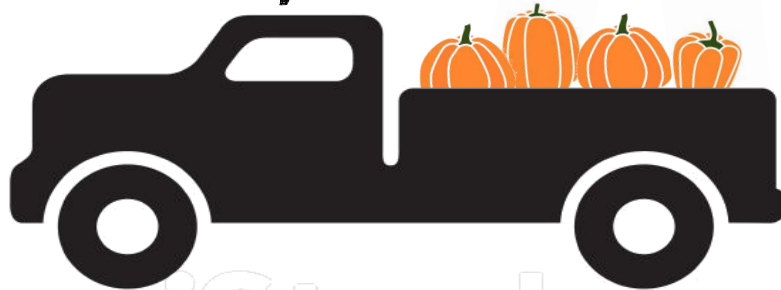
- ✦ Current gifts establishing a permanent endowment
