

If anyone hears my voice and opens the door,
I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me."

Revelation 3:20

I think one of the earliest songs I learned was "Into My Heart." It's a simple song but so very helpful.

"Into my heart, into my heart, Come into my heart, Lord Jesus; Come in today, come in to stay, Come into my heart, Lord Jesus."

The heart meant the center of who we are. The place from which our true desires and motives come. More than the organ or a physical place, it meant the spiritual center of our lives where our deepest beliefs, identity, and desires reside.

9/23—2 Corinthians 1:11—Guide us, Father, to be a church and community that prays together.


9/24—Ephesians 2:4-5—We pray together this day, Gracious God, for friends, family, and loved ones who need to be released from sin and made whole and holy in you.


