2 Cor 5: 20-21

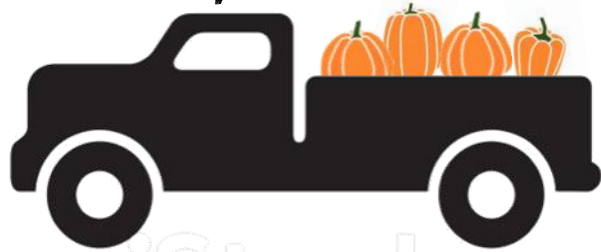
