STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

Why should I give to the church?

As Christians, we understand that everything we have comes from God. We give out of gratitude for our blessings and to support God's work through the church.

How much should I give?

The Bible teaches giving in proportion to the material blessings we have received. We encourage committing a percentage of your income and increasing that percentage over time.

When should I give?

Regular, systematic giving cultivates a lifestyle of generosity. Regular giving connects our generosity to our blessings. You can set up regular, recurring giving at wesleyumc.com/giving.

What does "tithe" mean?

It means giving the first tenth, or 10%, of our income to God, which originated in the Old Testament. When we give the first 10% of our income to the church, we put God first in our lives. We encourage setting a goal to reach or exceed this level of generosity. This is called "first fruits".
