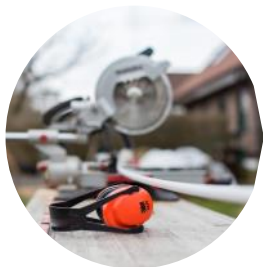
UMCOR/SAGER BROWN
